In order to define what is in the scope of the LOIHOA Board of Directors' responsibilities, the following Mission Statement was reviewed during the 2011 Annual Board Meeting:

Therefore, in order for the Board to have a complete understanding of the specific issue/situation and to enable the tracking of it to resolution, the Board requests that all such inquiries be submitted in writing.

The following process should be utilized:

- 2. The request should contain the following information:
  - a. State a summary of the issue/situation including date(s) of occurrence(s) in chronological order.
  - b. Provide photos, if applicable, of the "before" and "after".
  - c. State which specific resident right, in your opinion, was violated/compromised.
  - d. State what specific action you recommend be taken by the Board.
  - e. State what you are willing to do to assist in the mitigation of the issue/situation that you have presented to the Board.
- 3. The Board of Directors will review the request and will render a ruling, if the issue/situation is within the Board's scope of responsibilities. If not, it will inform the resident of same.
- 4. The Board's ruling will be sent to the requester via email or USPS.
